## **Postdoctoral Research Contract in Molecular Neurobiology**

### **Instituto de Neurociencias (Universidad Miguel Hernández-CSIC)**

Applications are invited for a research fellow in Molecular Neurobiology at the Instituto de Neurociencias, joint center of the Universidad Miguel Hernández and the CSIC, Alicante (Spain). The successful candidate will collaborate on a Consolider-Ingenio 2010 funded project (The Spanish Ion Channel Initiative, Ministry of Science and Innovation of Spain) investigating the role of different protein domains in biogenesis and gating of nicotinic acetylcholine receptors. This interdisciplinary project will use molecular biology, immunochemical, pharmacological and electrophysiological techniques in heterologously expressed receptors. The project will be supervised by Dr M Criado.

Candidates should have a PhD in molecular biology, neuroscience, or a related discipline. Experience in molecular biology is required and in cell biology would be convenient.

Salary will be 21900 € per annum. This post is presumably available at January 2009 and will be offered on a fixed-term contract for a period of two years that can be extended three more years.
